This faculty-led program will focus on comparing and contrasting more classical architectural styles in Paris, such as at Versailles, with modern architectural styles in Berlin, with a special focus on the Bauhaus movement in the early 20th century.

Time in Berlin will include a day-trip to Dessau, home of the School of Design, currently a UNESCO World Heritage site, as well as a day to explore the historical context of Berlin, by visiting the Reichstag and Checkpoint Charlie.

Our program is organized in collaboration with **Mr. Peter Carman**, President of Paris American Academy. Students will be housed within walking distance of Paris American Academy in Paris and centrally-located hotels in Berlin. Students should budget additional funds for at least one meal a day in Paris and Berlin.
