January 2 – January 18, 2024

Explore the rugged coastlines, rolling green hills of the countryside, and vibrant cities that compose the countries of the Republic of Ireland and Northern Ireland (U.K.) when you take part in this short term study abroad program January 2–18, 2024.

Renowned for its cultural history, artists, and peace workers, the island of Eire provides students the perfect context to learn about the rich history and art of the Celts as well as the historic Troubles in Northern Ireland through personal testimonies and excursions to ancient & historical sites. Expect to walk at least 4 miles /day, including ancient sites that are not handicapped accessible.

Choose between a 3-credit Fine Arts course, or a 3-credit Psychology course.

PREREQUISITE: for Fine Arts: Basic Drawing Skills (or ART 101) are encouraged to ensure success.

Program Cost: \$4,500

Tuition: Included as part of the regular Spring 2024 semester for full-time Mount Mary students.

Part-time students pay by credit hour and full-time students pay by credit hour for any overload credits.
