Mount Mary College to Host International Event

Annual Multicultural Fair features international fashion show, food, dance and music

MILWAUKEE (April 11, 2011) – Mount Mary College will host the second annual Multicultural Fair on its campus located at 2900 N. Menomonee River Parkway in Milwaukee. The event is free and open to the public. Ample free parking is also available.

The Mount Mary College Multicultural Fair will be held on Monday April 18, 2011 from 11:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. in the Alumnae Dining Room located in Bergstrom Hall. She has partnered with organizations such as Girls Inc., the YMCA, Girl Scouts of the USA, the Dove Self-Esteem Fund, and Derek Jeter’s Turn 2 Foundation, and was invited to the White House based on her work in domestic violence prevention and youth development.
