



## IMPORTANT HEALTH INSURANCE INFORMATION

Health insurance is required for all Mount Mary College students. You may already have health insurance through your family plan but you should know that if you have coverage in a more restrictive health plan or managed care network, your access to care away from home may not be what you expect or need. Please review your present health care coverage to ensure that you have adequate coverage in the Milwaukee metropolitan area. If you find that you have additional insurance needs, you may want to consider another option.

As a student at Mount Mary College, you are eligible to purchase a college-sponsored Student Health Insurance Plan. The 2008-09 plan is with United Healthcare StudentResources, a leading agent in student health and accident insurance plans. This plan was carefully designed to provide care for Mount Mary College students. It covers you for a full year, regardless of summer enrollment status. Most covered benefits pay at 80% of preferred allowance for United Healthcare Network providers and 60% of usual and customary for out of network providers.

In addition we have made arrangements with Advance Health Care Clinic on Mayfair Road to act as our Student Health Center. It is located at 3289 N. Mayfair Road and is open 7 days a week from 8am to 9pm. To make an appointment, students can call 414-771-7900 or use the walk-in clinic. Students under the United Healthcare StudentResources Mount Mary plan will have no co-pay, no deductible, and covered services will be covered at 100%, meaning no out of pocket expenses to the student. Mount Mary College student not under the UHCSR insurance plan can receive services at Advanced Health Care, but will be subject to the provisions of their own insurance policy (networks, co-pays, and deductibles).

Menomonee River Parkway, Milwaukee, WI 53222. Payment can be through a check to Mount Mary College or the premium cost can be added to your student account through signing an authorization in the Office of Student Affairs in Caroline Hall, Room 147. Once enrolled in the plan the coverage will have taken effect August 1, 2008, if your application is received by August 26, 2008.**

Premium costs:

Annual coverage (8/1/08 to 7/31/09)	\$715
Fall coverage (8/1/08 to 12/31/08)	\$300
Spring/Summer coverage (1/1/09 to 7/31/09)	\$415
