### Layton Art Scholarship

Annually, Mount Mary College offers \$3,000 in Layton Art Scholarship funds to incoming students as well as returning students within the Arts and Design Division. Scholarship applicants must have a high school GPA of 3.0 or higher and attend Mount Mary College full time. Students may reapply for the scholarship each year they are enrolled at Mount Mary. It is a high honor to receive the Layton Art Scholarship at Mount Mary College, an institution well-known for its art programs.

### Facilities and Technology

Mount Mary College has the most recent, state-of-the-art computer systems, drafting equipment, and technology for proper learning and training. Our computer graphics labs, screen printing lab, and surface design studio are all top notch. Ceramics students use a variety of techniques with gas, electric, and raku kilns on campus and a bio-fueled salt glazing kiln.

Also available for student creativity are computers for PowerPoint presentations, DVD players and recorders, videos on design techniques, mat cutting equipment, propane torches for jewelry making, electric saws, printmaking presses, benchpins, and projection equipment. And a student lounge for the sole use by Arts and Design students.
