



ANTICIPATED COSTS AND FEES FOR DIETETIC INTERNSHIP

All graduate students at Mount Mary College are subject to the tuition and fees described in the graduate bulletin (available online at www.mtmary.edu/classes.htm). Since these costs are subject to change, students are urged to contact the Office for Graduate and Continuing Education, (414) 256-1252, for updated tuition and fee information or go online to www.mtmary.edu/tuitiongrad.htm. Costs for books, course materials, housing and transportation vary depending on the individual and the course requirements. On-campus housing is available to graduate students. DI Participation Fee (assessed in addition to tuition): \$450 per year, includes program administration costs, background check and professional liability insurance

Books (depending on student's resources and individual needs): \$350 - \$600

Two Lab Coats: \$40 - \$80

Affiliate ADA Membership: \$49

Milwaukee Dietetic Association Membership (annual student rate; recommended, not required): \$15

Application Fee (includes application to graduate program): \$35

On-Campus Housing: Costs for Mount Mary College Room and Board vary. Find out more at www.mtmary.edu/residencelife.htm. Space in the Mount Mary College residence hall is on a first-come, first-served basis.

Off-Campus Housing: Mount Mary College is located in a residential area on Milwaukee's northwest side. A two-bedroom apartment shared by two people in the Milwaukee area averages \$450 to \$600 per person, per month.

Transportation to Experience Sites: Variable

A private vehicle is necessary as sites are from four to 45 miles from campus and public transportation is not feasible. Affiliates may require proof of auto liability insurance and/or assess parking fees.

Physical Exam: Variable

Documentation of current inoculations, titers and TB testing are required. Health insurance is required for all interns. Information about obtaining health insurance is available online at www.mtmary.edu/healthservices.htm.

Financial Assistance: To alleviate some costs, Mount Mary has a limited number of graduate assistantships available to enrolled students.
