Honors Program Criteria

"Graduation in the Honors Program" is designated on the diploma and transcripts of students who successfully meet the following criteria:

- Maintain a 3.5 cumulative grade point average (GPA) at time of graduation.
- Complete six academic honors points by participating in an honors seminar, taking honors courses, writing a thesis and/or studying abroad.
- Complete four extra-curricular honors points by participating in personal growth activities.

Exclusive Program Opportunities

By becoming an Honors Program member, students have the opportunity to participate in some of the following exclusive activities:

- Participating in monthly meetings with other honor students
- Receiving academic advising from the program director
- Presenting a paper at a convention
- Writing a thesis
- Enrolling in honors courses such as
 - Terrorism, McWorld and the Challenge to Democracy
 - One Nation Under God: Religious Diversity in the United States
 - A Shifting Paradigm: Art Meets Science
 - Spirituality and Women and the Holocaust

Eligibility

To be considered for acceptance into the Honors Program, qualified candidates must:

- Have a minimum of a 3.5 grade point average (GPA) in high school or at her previous academic institution.
- Be accepted into Mount Mary College.
- Demonstrate involvement in extra-curricular and service related activities.

- A typed essay of no more than 500 words written by the applicant addressing the following:
 - Personal academic goals
 - Details of extra-curricular and service related activities
 - Explanation regarding desire to be a part of the Honors Program
