FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why get a Masters Degree?

- Therapists need to develop new services to take advantage of health care trends
- Enhance your marketability for desirable jobs.

How Long will It take?

- 1 to 2 years.

How do the classes work?

- Courses are offered online.
- Students complete work at times convenient for them.
- Assignments are generally due once per week for 8 weeks.
- Most students work full-time.

How much will it cost?

Tuition in 2008-09 is \$545 per credit. Graduate students are eligible for student loans.

What are the admission requirements?

- Bachelor's degree in occupational therapy.
- Certified or licensed as an occupational therapist.
