

## Urban Education Fellows Program – Course Work Schedule

### 1-8 Middle Childhood/Early Adolescence Licensure & Master’s of Arts in Education

During the initial summer, Fellows participate in a full-time, seven-week summer field experience to prepare them for Fall teaching positions. From mid-June through the end of July, Monday-Friday, 8AM-4PM, time is spent in sessions learning with the coaches, in classrooms teaching students, and at the colleges taking coursework. Continued coaching, teaching, and coursework is integrated throughout the remaining six semesters of the program.

UEF 608 Reading	3 cr.	<i>Emphasis on a balanced approach to the integration of reading, writing, and language arts.</i>
UEF 606 Science Methods*	3 cr.	<i>Focus on knowledge and skills of teaching science with links to math</i>
<b>Year Two Summer</b>		
UEF 605 Social Studies Methods*	3 cr.	<i>Focus on knowledge and skills of teaching social studies with links to reading and language arts; specific focus on diversity</i>
UEF 614 Curriculum & Assessment	3 cr.	<i>Focus on principles and practice of curriculum and assessment across all subject areas</i>
UEF 609 Intro. to Action Research	3 cr.	<i>Focus on research problems addressing questions systematically to improve classroom practice with focus on literacy and math</i>

UEF 610 Adapting Strategies to the Needs of Diverse Learners	4 cr.	<i>Work with curriculum and instruction to meet learner needs</i>
UEF 611 Action Research II	2 cr.	<i>Continuation of action research project</i>

UEF 612 Instructional Strategies Integrated with the Arts	4 cr.	<i>Focus on expanding ways to engage learners; also incorporates preparation for portfolio defense</i>
UEF 613 Action Research III	2 cr.	<i>Continuation of action research project</i>

UEF 607 Health & Movement	3 cr.	<i>Emphasis on these areas and their integration into the curriculum</i>
UEF 615 Teacher Leadership	3 cr.	<i>Issues of education and organizational leadership</i>
UEF 616 Capstone Seminar	3 cr.	<i>Linking action research with the development of the professional development plan</i>
