



DEGREE COMPLETION AGREEMENT BETWEEN

WAUKESHA COUNTY TECHNICAL COLLEGE

AND

MOUNT MARY COLLEGE

Effective March 30, 2010

The purpose of this degree completion agreement is to provide a seamless transfer process for learners at Waukesha County Technical College (WCTC) who desire further education to enter Mount Mary College. Through the collaborative efforts of faculty, student services, and administration, learners will encounter a clear path to reach their educational goals.

Learners who successfully complete an A.A.S. degree at WCTC and who meet the admission requirements of Mount Mary College and any other conditions specified in this agreement will be admitted to the designated program at Mount Mary College with up to 64 credits toward their degree.

NOTE: Mount Mary College and WCTC also have articulation agreements for accounting, business, fashion merchandise, graphic design and justice. Information regarding these agreements can be obtained through Mount Mary's Vice President for Academic and Student Affairs, (414) 256-1203.

Unless otherwise noted, a grade of C (2.0) or better at WCTC is required for credits to transfer to Mount Mary College.

PROVISIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT:

1. **Admission.** It is the learner's responsibility to demonstrate fulfillment of the current admission requirements of Mount Mary College at the time of entry.
2. **Advising.** Mount Mary College will provide academic advising to WCTC learners inquiring about Mount Mary College programs. Mount Mary College will provide materials, catalogs, and other information to WCTC counselors to facilitate their understanding of requirements and programs. WCTC will assist Mount Mary College in arranging recruitment events on its campuses.

DETAILS REGARDING THE A.A.S. DEGREE TO LIBERAL STUDIES DEGREE:

Students must complete an A.A.S. degree at WCTC in order to be eligible for admission to the Mount Mary College Liberal Studies program.

A maximum of 64 credits from a combination of the student's occupational program requirements and other course work will be accepted for transfer.

Additional Liberal Studies course work to be completed at Mount Mary College:

The Liberal Studies major consists of Mount Mary College's 48 credit core plus the following:

Additional graduate requirements to be fulfilled at Mount Mary College:

1. **Graduation Requirement.** A total of 128 credits are required to graduate. Credits may include a combination of student's occupational program requirements and other course work accepted for transfer. The last 32 credits must be earned at Mount Mary.
2. **48 credits must be earned in the Core.** Transfer credits may count towards fulfillment of Core credits. See core transfer list below.
3. **Math Competency.** Math competency can be fulfilled by achieving a passing score on a competency test at Mount Mary College, by earning a grade of C or better in one of the following math courses, or other preapproved courses, at WCTC:

804-106 Introduction to College Math
804-123 Math with Business Applications
804-115 College Technical Math 1

or by earning a grade of C or better in a specific math course at Mount Mary. Transfer students with more than 60 credits must fulfill this requirement within their first 16 credits at Mount Mary.

4. **Global Competency.** All Mount Mary students are required to take one course (3-4 credits) in a "global designated" course. Generally this requirement is fulfilled at Mount Mary.

MOUNT MARY COLLEGE CORE TRANSFER LIST:

WCTC students may take the following courses toward fulfillment of the 48 credit Core requirement at Mount Mary College. A maximum of 64 credits from the student's occupational program requirements and additional course work will be accepted for transfer. Upon review by Mount Mary College, additional courses may be eligible for core credit.
