In addition, employees of the Waukesha County Chamber of Commerce member organizations who already hold a bachelor's degree can receive a five percent discount off the tuition for the Master of Business Administration (MBA) program.

From its inception, Mount Mary College has been a women's college. Benefit-eligible male employees of the Waukesha County Chamber of Commerce member organizations are welcome to enroll in the undergraduate Nursing BSN Completion and the MBA programs.

### Application process:

Mount Mary College requires the employee to obtain from a human resources representative, a yearly letter indicating current status as a benefit-eligible employee. The letter should be submitted electronically to Judy Borawski, Corporate Grant Coordinator at Mount Mary College, borawskj@mtmary.edu.

Along with the employer letter, interested students need to apply for admission to the College.
