MOUNT MARY COLLEGE ALUMNAE ART EXHIBIT • JANUARY 29 - FEBRUARY 24, 2012

Juried exhibition featuring the work of alumnae from Mount Mary College, 2900 N. Menomonee River Pky., Milwaukee, WI 53222

Awards

- Both monetary and nonmonetary prizes will be awarded.
- Dollar amount awarded will be based upon the number of entries received.

Jury

- Jurying will be conducted by professional outside jurors, under the final discretion of the Marian Art Gallery director.

Eligibility

- The juried exhibition is open to all Mount Mary College alumnae who were enrolled in an art class or program.
- A limit of two entries with a \$20 nonrefundable entry fee per person.
- One-page artist statement including contact information for gallery customers.
- Submitted work must have been done outside of Mount Mary since graduation.
- Artworks previously exhibited in the Marian Art Gallery are not eligible for entry.

Rules

- Only original works of art may be submitted.
- Two-dimensional entries must be framed and ready for hanging with hook eyes or wire.
- Pedestals for 3-D work will be provided by the Marian Art Gallery.
- All 2-D work must be under glass or plexiglass unless approved by the director.
- For applicable 2-D and 3-D work, provide dimensions of each piece as follows: Height x Width x Depth. **Indicate sizes as inches (") or as feet (').**

- Size requirements for 2-D art should not exceed 6'.
- Three-dimensional art should not exceed 6' of floor space and should weigh less than 50lbs.
- Wall-installed work must be suitably framed or in an alternative presentation form and ready to install. All work without an appropriate hanging apparatus will be disqualified. All media is permissible. Entries that do not comply with the rules will be disqualified.

Submission

- Works are to be delivered to Marian Art Gallery on January 14, from 9 am to Noon. If you need other arrangements, please contact Barbara Heimsch at 414-259-1440.
- Identification labels must be securely fixed to the back of the work with tape or any other removable method. Identification labels must be completed prior to delivery.
- Each artist may submit up to two pieces to be juried. Works should be picked up promptly on the specified dates.
- Collection of unselected work will be January 14 from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. Artists will be notified by telephone only in the case of all pieces being accepted. If you do not receive a phone call you must assume you need to pick up the unselected art work.

Details

- The utmost care will be taken in handling work. However, neither the Marian Art Gallery nor Mount Mary College shall be responsible for lost or damaged work. Artists are advised to have business cards available in Marian Art

Gallery for prospective buyers. The Marian Art Gallery will not charge a commission.

- If work is shipped, artist must include paid return shipping labels.
- Work must be available for the duration of the exhibit.
- Video installations require the artist to supply ALL of their own equipment.
- Artists must send detailed descriptions for display for any alternative install methods, showing in detail how these pieces will be installed.
