



## Helpful Information about the Mount Mary Student Health Insurance with UHCSR

All students will get a mailing about the UHCSR plan offered by Mount Mary during the month of July. Additional brochures/enrollment packets will be kept in Student Affairs.

By July 1, information about the plan will be available on the United Health Care Student Resources Home Page. To view the information, go to: <http://www.uhcsr.com/>. Click on “find my school’s plan”. Select Mount Mary. Then you will see brochure, temporary insurance cards, enrollment form, and continuation form. Once enrolled, students can also create their account to print insurance cards, view claims, and find directories of providers at this website.

Students will arrange their enrollment in the plan through Mount Mary. They can have the insurance added to their student account or pay by check. Enrollment will be handled by Student Affairs.

Optional Major Med 200K is available as a “buy up” for \$469 annually (which the student would fill out the enrollment form and mail into UHCSR)

Dependents (Spouses and Children) can be enrolled as well. See the Dependent Enrollment Form included in the packets or available at [www.uhcsr.com](http://www.uhcsr.com) for prices. Enrollment for dependents will be through UHCSR directly.

All international students will be required to purchase this plan. All resident students must show proof of insurance and those without insurance will be required to purchase this plan. Any other Mount Mary student without coverage can voluntarily purchase the plan. Again, arrangements for purchasing the plan need to be made with Student Affairs.

For students familiar with the plan from last year, there will be no location acting as the Mount Mary Student Health Center. The Advanced Health Care Clinic on Mayfair Road will be treated as a regular in-network provider, meaning student should plan on their insurance paying covered expense at 80% after any applicable copays (20% remains payable by the student, plus copays).
